As the holiday season comes to a close and we begin the New Year, we continue to battle the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. We are seeing an increase in exposures throughout our community among both residents and staff members. Please continue to follow the core principles of infection prevention of masking, distancing, and hand hygiene. All residents and visitors must have a mask covering their mouth and nose when outside of their apartment homes.

Due to the increase in COVID-19 cases and exposures within Cook County, the Cook County Health Department has issued a new requirement for all **visitors/guests, ages 5 and up**, regarding dining within the county. These requirements will impact our community. Please read the below carefully:

Effective on Monday, January 3, 2022 all visitors must show proof of vaccination to dine at Mosaic, Seasons, Herman's, and Blue Stone.

Guests that are unable to provide proof of vaccination will be unable to dine within these venues.

We recognize that this is a change that will require your continued support and cooperation. We are asking for your ongoing assistance and collaboration as we follow the necessary guidance in our efforts to keep you, our staff, and our visitors safe and well.
