*Tuesday, March 2 at 12:30 PM & Friday, March 5 at 11:30 AM Channel 1901*

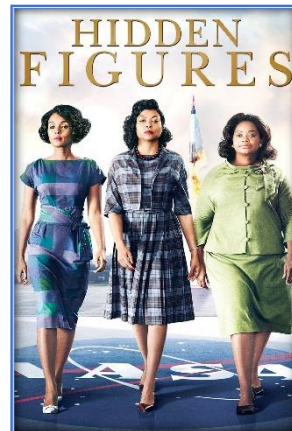
Tune in and catch Bob Ross painting a little lakeside path in a secluded place; you'll delight in the discovery of a small uninhabited island.
