Shopping Trip to WINGS Resale Shop

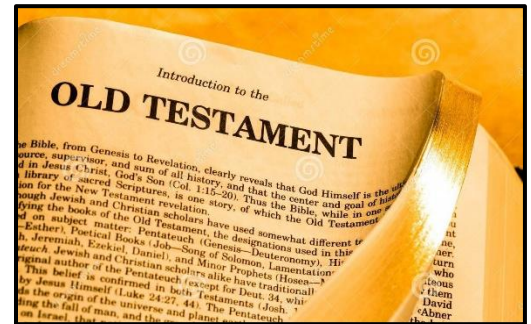
Tuesday, January 11th

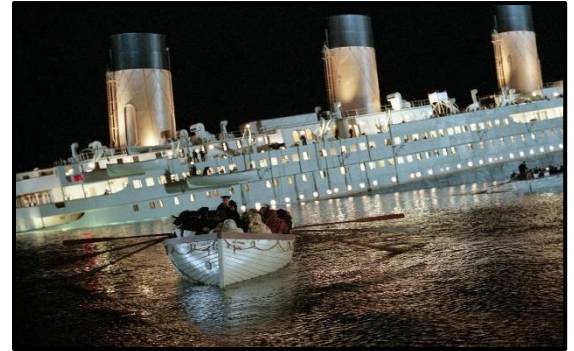
Walmart Shopping Time Change
